

#### i. Non-Payment of fees:

- The school management expects all parents to pay fees on time so that the general operations of the school are conducted unhindered.
- Incase of non payment fee for more than a month, the parents will receive two remainders through e-mails to clear the fees.
- Failure to respond to the e-mails sent by the school, the school reserves the right to issue TC to such students.
- Re-admission of such students will be considered only after payment
  of full fees (current and outstanding fees of the current academic term)
  in advance.
- A late fee fine can be charged by the school management depending upon the delay in paying the fees. Any non-payment of fees due to systems failure will be handled by the school management on a case to case basis.

#### ii. Withdrawal & Refund of fees:

- a. In any case, any student applies for a Transfer Certificate (TC) in the middle of the Academic Year, TC with be provided if only all the feess (such as the term fees, activity fee and support fee) are paid and there are no fees due to the school.
- b. Fees refund of students seeking withdrawal will be decided on a case to case basis by the management depending on the circumstances under which refund and withdrawal is sought by the parent.
- c. Any parent wanting to discontinue the transport or health (catering) programme must send in writting 10 days before the payment of next installment due.
- d. If a student has attended even a day of an academic session and wishes to withdraw, then the admission, activity, support, academic, transport and health fee for the term will not be refunded.
- e. If a withdrawl notice is not received by the school and at the same time the child has not attended the school, the fees due to the school will be applicable for the child.

# LOST & FOUND SECTION

#### CODE OF CONDUCT

BHIS Kelambakkam fosters an open and interactive learning environment and understands that growing children need the right balance of freedom and control to grow up as adults and add value to the society in the future.

In keeping with this mission of the school the following are basic discipline guidelines for students -

- Students must wear school uniforms on all days and as per the school's academic and activities schedules.
- Students must maintain personal and physical hygiene at all times and corrective actions must be taken by the parents promptly if students are informed by their teachers on any such aspects.
- Students are required to maintain proper decorum in the school such as use
  of appropriate language, salutation to elders and respect for their fellow
  students.
- Students walking within the campus ie in the corridors or returning from the sports fields should be in the form of a single line especially when classes are in progress. During break time students are allowed to walk and talk in groups as long as they maintain the general and expected level of decorum and discipline.
- Students are expected to name tag any spare clothing, their books, water bottles or tiffin boxes when bringing them to school.
- Students shall not wear any expensive jewellery, watches or other such items to school.
- Students must participate in all school activities, unless an exemption letter is sent in advance to the class teacher.
- Students are expected to reach school between 8:15 am and 8:30 am every morning. In case, students are having breakfast in school they must arrive by 8:00 am.
- Students coming late for more than two days in a month will be marked absent on the third day, if they are late. This will have an impact on the overall attendance of the child during that particular academic year.

#### **MALPRACTICE**

- 1. The school has zero tolerance against any type of malpractice adopted by leaners during examination
- 2. If a child is found cheating during the examination, the answer script will be confiscated by the invigilator.
- 3. A fresh answer script will be issued by the examination committee and the student will be assessed on the basis of the new answer script.

#### LIBRARY RULES

Books other than reference books are issued to a student for a period of one week. Reference books are also issued to the students during the weekend for a period of two days. If the library books are returned late without a valid reason, the borrowing facility can be temporarily withdrawn.

Books marked, disfigured or damaged will have to be replaced or paid for by the borrower.

#### GUIDANCE FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS

- REGULARLY CHECK Parent app of the school for home extension assignments and other notifications from the school.
- Parents who would like to pickup her child early from school must seek
  for prior permission by sending e-mail through the class teacher or
  academic head.
- Parents must meet teachers by fixing up a prior appointment. Teachers cannot be disturbed during the class hours.

#### **ABSENCE**

- Students who have been sick must bring a medical certificate from their doctor on the day of joining the school.
- Parents must send a formal leave request, stating the reason for absence through MCB in advance.
- No one who has been absent on the previous day will be admitted to the class without a leave request stating reason for absence sent via MCB/e-mail.
- Leave for going out of station must be approved prior to proceeding on leave.
- Repeated absence without leave or unexplained absence for more than six consecutive days renders the students liable to have his/ her name struck of the rolls. Re-admission may be granted only on payment of fresh admission fee.
- It is compulsory for the students to have 80% of the attendance in the academic session to by eligible to sit for the final examination.

#### BONAFIDE & TRANSFER CERTIFICATE REQUEST

- Transfer certificate will be issued if all dues of the school are settled and clear notice period is given to the school stating the reason of the Transfer.
- If the Transfer Certificate is lost or misplaced, a new certificate will be issued by the school upon one-week notice in advance by email to the school.
- Bonafide certificates will not be issued until the total Academic year due for the term is paid. Only 1 Bonafide certificate will be issued per Academic year after clear confirmation of the details from the parent.

#### SCHOOL BUS TRANSPORTATION RULES & REGULATIONS

- The School will provide transport to its students for any location that is less than 20 kms from the school on payment of the designated fee for the route.
   Management reserves the right to admit or deny the allocation of transport to any student.
- The request to avail transportation must be given well in advance to the Transport In-charge or Admin Officer so that the availability of seats can be checked and communicated to the parent.
- The parent must pay the applicable fee for the said facility before availing the same. Once the fee is paid, Head of accounts will intimate the Transport In-Charge about the same via mail.
- The residence must be feasible enough for the school bus to travel without any hindrance or causing delay to fellow students of the bus.
- Any last-minute requests for availing transportation will be available only subject to the availability of seats and on first come first serve basis.
- Students must not change transport vehicles allocated to them without the permission of the Transport In-Charge.
- Students must maintain discipline while using the school Transport.
   Indiscipline in the bus such as fighting, talking loudly, disturbing fellow passengers or breaking school assets is not allowed and will be subject to disciplinary action.

#### COMMUNICATION OF PICK UP AND DROP POINTS

- Before availing of the Transport facility from the school, the pickup and drop points
  must be clearly communicated to the Transport in-charge and no changes will be
  entertained frequently on the same as it affects the pick-up and drop timings of fellow
  Students of the same bus. In case any changes in residence location, the changed location
  and request for new transportation will be mailed by the parent well in advance and the
  transport in-charge will check the feasibility of providing the facility to the changed
  address.
- Parents must be available at the pickup and drop points to pick up their wards in the said time to avoid unnecessary delay to other students travelling in the same bus. Students will not be handed over to unknown persons considering the safety of the students. In case a guidance comes to pickup a child from the school or at the drop point, same has to be communicated with relavant document to the school in advance.
- In case of delays in pickup of the student, the bus will not wait for a student and if regularly late, the child will be denied transportation for the term. In case of delays to collect the student at the time of returning home, the bus will not wait for the parent and the child will be brought back to school. The parent will collect the child from the school.
- The Contact number of the parent should be reachable for any communication from the school. In case of change of contact number, the parent undertakes to keep the Transport In charge notified.
- Parents are requested to use the GPS tracking option to track the location of the bus. In case of the issue with Tracking, parents can immediately raise the concern with the Transport In charge.

#### TRANSPORT FEE:

- The Transport fee for students depends on the distance of the students place of pick up or drop from school and not based on classes.
- The transport fee is to be paid for the term in full before availing the facility, otherwise the same will not be provided.
- The transport fee does not qualify for any discounts like sibling discount, staff discount, one-time payment and so on, except in the case of "Privilege Parent discount" (Explained separately).
- The fee for one-way transport is the same as two-way transport and no separate fee structure is available for one way transportation.

#### NON-REFUNDABLE CLAUSE OF TRANSPORT FEE:

- The Transport fee once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- Students who get admitted in mid-year and wish to avail transport are required to pay the term fee for transport they are joining in to avail the facility based on the availability of the same.

- In case any student opts to withdraw from the school transport during midyear, the transport fee for the term if already paid will not be refunded and if unpaid, must be paid in full to obtain the Transfer Certificate.
- Privileged Parent Discount: The School Board, as a noble gesture of honouring the first 50 parents who enrolled their wards with trust in BHIS-Kelambakkam had provided 50% discount on Transport fee in the academic year 2018-19. The discounts are lifetime till the students are a part of Billabong Kelambakkam. However, if they choose to withdraw the Transport facility during the tenure of the student in the school, the privilege parent discount will not be applicable. Also, the discounts are applicable only if the facilities were opted for in the same year (2018-19), the first academic year of the school and not on any subsequent academic year.
- The Board of Directors will communicate a regular deadline for each term for payment of fees and parents are expected to pay the fee for their wards before that due date. If parents fails to pay the fee or remains unresponsive to calls and mails from the Accounts department, the transportation facility will be withdrawn for the ward.
- As per the School fee Policy, the parent may choose to pay the whole year fee
  in instalments as per the approval from the Board. In case, the dues are not
  received in time as agreed upon the facility will be withdrawn after
  communicating to the parents.

#### SCHOOL HEALTH PROGRAMME RULES AND REGULATIONSS

- Parents availing the health programme must fill up the food allergy forms.
- Any request for change must be intimated one month in advance to the Culture Custodian.
- Health Programme fees will be collected in advance for the full term. In case of discontinuation of the programme, the fees will not be refunded. The same applies for long absence.


